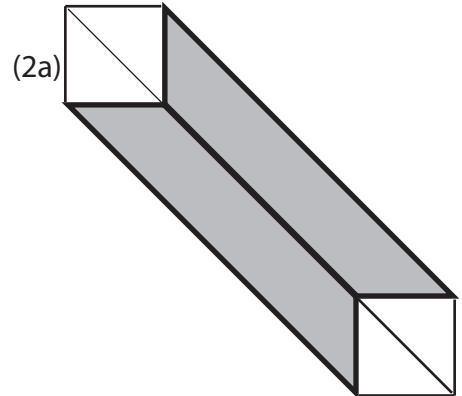
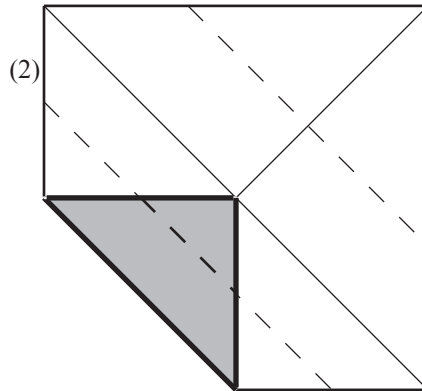
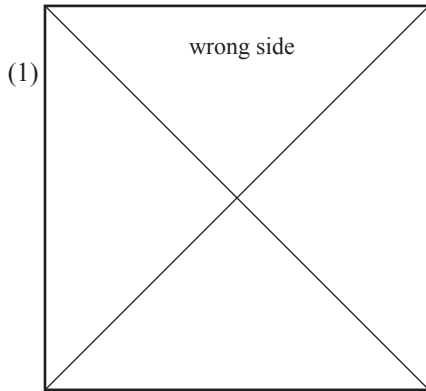
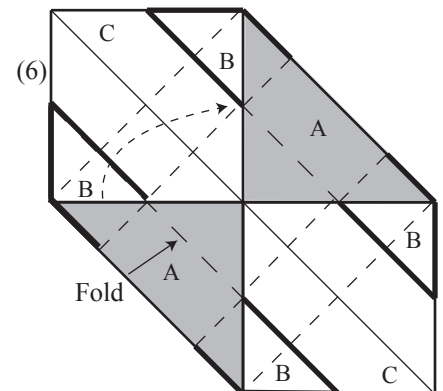
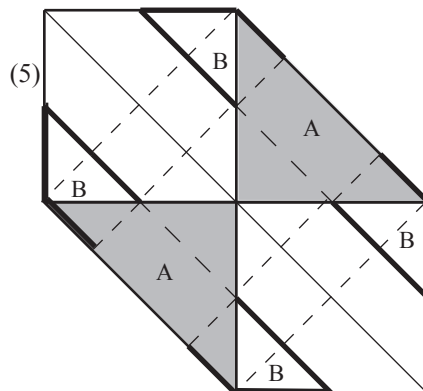
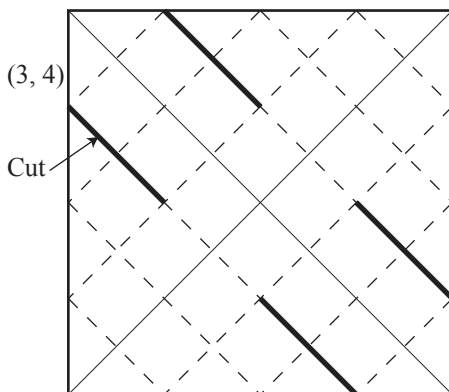


# Petite Box a la Card



1. From greeting-card weight paper, cut a perfect square. Mark two placement lines, point-to-point, diagonally on the wrong side.
2. Fold the paper, lower left corner and upper right corner, along the dashed lines as shown. Continue folding as shown in step 2a.
3. Unfold the paper and crease the upper left and lower right corners in the same manner. Unfold the square paper to reveal the creased lines.
4. Along the creases where indicated in bold, cut 4 straight lines as shown.
5. Fold the lower left and upper right corners A at the original fold lines as shown.
6. Fold sides A up at 90° angles along the crease lines and bring sections B together to create the other two sides.
7. Bring C up and over sections B and fold them over to hold the B sides in place. You will now have a box.
8. Cut another square  $\frac{1}{4}$ " smaller than the first square.\* Make another box as described in steps 1-7. The two boxes become a pair that will nest together as a complete box--top and bottom.



\*This bottom square may need to be slightly smaller than suggested when using heavier card stock or paper fused with fabric.
